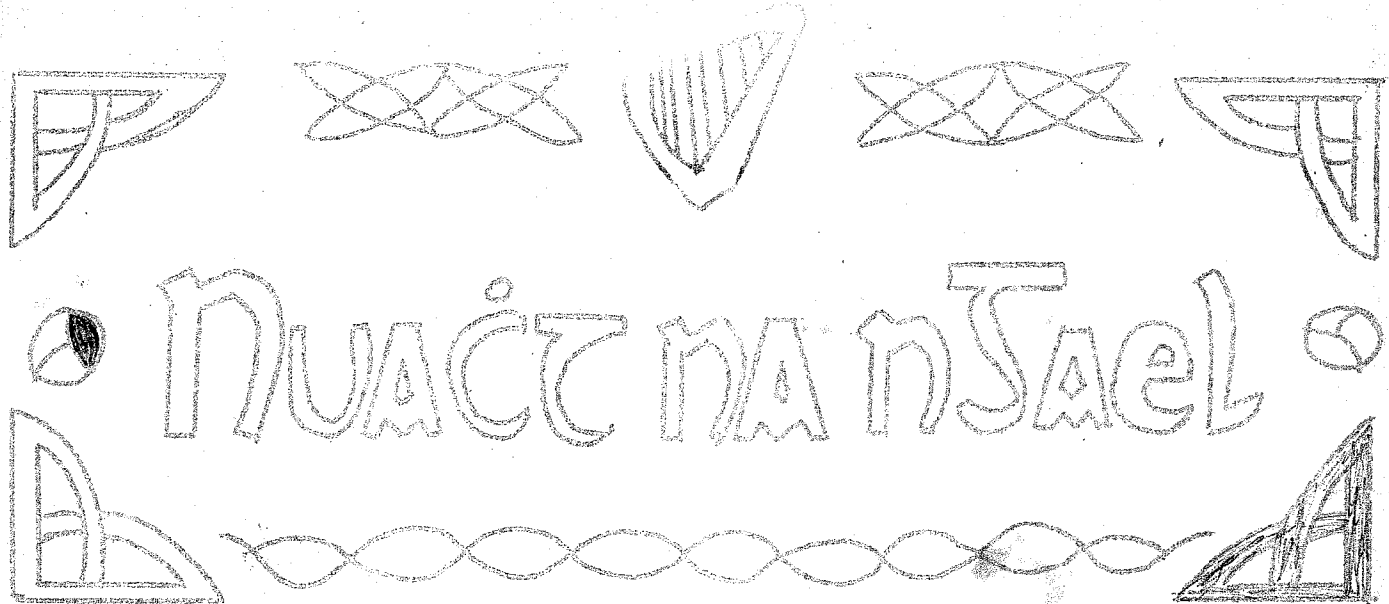




THE NEW YORK PHILLO CELTIC SOCIETY
