

There are other areas which deserve consideration -- discipline, parent-teacher relations, vocational guidance -- but there will be another time, another place ....maybe another person.

In conclusion, let me return to the personal tenor of the opening and assert that teaching in Ireland was a positive experience. Partially because it forced my professional thinking in a way which had never happened before. Partially because it enabled me to see some advantages in methods and attitudes which were more confining and rigoristic than I had experienced. But mainly because the children I met will remind me for years of the promise of Ireland, and continue my indignation that anything in their preparation for life may not be the best.
